Hello Parents and Guardians of Herndon Magnet School Students, this is Tom Thomas, Principal of Herndon Magnet School, with Herndon Highlights for the week of August 27th:

- The Hawks Football Team will play Homer at N. Caddo Stadium on Tuesday, August 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 PM.
- K-8 students will have school yearbook pictures taken on Thursday, August 30<sup>th</sup>. Students will need to wear school uniforms.
- There will be a Joint Scouting Informational Night at Herndon on Thursday, August 30<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM in the auditorium.
- The PTSA will be selling Hawk Treats on Friday, August 31<sup>st</sup> for elementary students.
- There will be a Back to School Social for middle school on Friday, August 31<sup>st</sup>. Students will need money if they plan to buy items from concessions.
- Friday, August 31<sup>st</sup> is a street clothes day for students. Please go over page 12 in the agenda with your student before this day so that no one has to call home for a uniform to be brought to school. Students not following CPSB guidelines will lose the next street clothes opportunity.
- Middle school students need to return their clean PE uniforms every Monday. They may put them in their gym lockers before school.
- All kindergarten, first grade, and 2nd grade students must keep the bus and car rider backpack tags on their backpacks for the entire school year. Please do not remove these tags. If there is a permanent change during the school year, please let your child's teacher know, and let the office know as well.
- If your kindergarten child is a permanent car rider, and you only have the one child, please stay to the left in the car rider line and pull your car up as far as you can. We will do our best to get you in and out quickly in the afternoons. Parents that are picking up just middle school students or a combination of elementary and middle, please line up in the car line between 3:10 and 3:15 PM. All parents must stay in their vehicles when picking up students in the car line.
- If you do not write a note or call the office before 2:15 PM about a transportation changes, your student will be put on their afternoon bus.
- We appreciate everyone who has used Payforit.net to pay class fees. I know there is a small convenience fee, but paying online helps us keep fees straight and students are not bringing cash or checks to school. This also saves valuable instruction time.
