Hello Parents and Guardians of Herndon Magnet School Students, this is Tom Thomas, Principal of Herndon Magnet School, with Herndon Highlights for the week of August 28th:

- Back to School Night is Tuesday, August 29 at 6:00 PM. We are asking that you start in the auditorium so that you can hear important information and instructions about Back to School night. Please know that this is an opportunity to hear from the teachers about the class. This is not a time for a parent-teacher conference.
- K-8 school pictures will be Thursday, August 31. Students are to wear their uniforms.
- Friday, September 1 is a street clothes day. Please follow page 12 of the student handbook. Students who are in violation of street clothes guidelines will lose the opportunity to wear street clothes for the remainder of the 9 weeks.
- Middle school will have a Back to School Social on Friday, September 1. Concessions will be available to middle school students at the social, as well as PINK Week items.
- Middle school PE uniforms must be brought home on Fridays to be washed, and they must be returned on Mondays. Students are required to dress out each day for PE.
- Parents and Guardians, just as a reminder, students cannot be dropped off in front of the school in the morning. Car riders must be let off at the turn around. If you arrive after 7:50 am, you must sign your student in at the office.
- We are requesting that if your students are permanent car riders in the afternoon that parents who are picking up just kindergarten, 1st graders, and 2nd graders line up first. If you have 3rd-8th graders or a combination of any of the aforementioned, that you line up last. This will help afternoon dismissal run more efficient.
