Our teachers and students have not only been working diligently to master the LSS, but also to prepare to take their tests. The tests are very different from the CAT or GEE that you may remember taking. Not only are the tests computer based for students in grades 5 – 8, but even the paper-based tests for students in grades 3 and 4 require much more than bubbling in an answer. One way that you can help us help your child is to practice the "Online Training Tools" with them at home.

Students need practice using the technology and knowing the layout of the test on the computer. Technology enhanced items include drag and drop, hot spots, and matching interaction. The math tests include typing in the equation editor. All of the tests require typing of short answers, paragraphs, and essays. Additionally, students need practice enlarging pictures, maps, and graphs, ensuring they scroll down to see the entire document, moving between questions, using the review screen at the end of the test to ensure all questions have been answered, and knowing how to use all available tools as needed/required.

Parents can greatly improve their child's knowledge of and usage of these items by having them practice and show you how it works at home. Over the next couple of weeks, please take some time on several different occasions to go to <a href="https://wbte.drcedirect.com/LA/portals/la">https://wbte.drcedirect.com/LA/portals/la</a> with your child. Click on "Online Tools Training" under the LEAP 2025 Grades 3 – 8 blue button. You will then get a menu of items for ELA, math, science, and social studies. Each test has several practice questions and items for your child to practice. Students have been exposed to these in their classrooms, but being very familiar with the testing platform will help put students at ease when testing rolls around. Ask them to show you how to use the different tools; look around and click on every available item so that you can see for yourself what the LEAP 2025 will be like for your child.
