4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades will participate in the EOY Pep Rally tomorrow, May 14<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 AM. Since this Pep Rally is for Herndon students, please allow us to get all students seated before entering the gym.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> grade will have their annual spelling bee in the auditorium at 10:30 AM tomorrow, May 14<sup>th</sup>.
