I need to correct some misinformation that you may have received. The last day of school for students is Thursday, May 17th. Teachers will be taking attendance, and students will be working and participating in activities through the last day of school.

Students going on the PTSA Limo Ride to Johnny's pizza tomorrow, May 10th, may wear street clothes that meet CPSB policy.

Students need to have all overdue library books turned in by Friday, May 11th. Also, all debts must be cleared up by Friday, May 11th as well.

The Kindergarten Commencement will begin at 8:30 AM on Friday, May 11th. Following the Commencement, kindergarten will present "Kindergarten – The Greatest Show on Earth."

The 8th Grade Commencement will begin at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, May 15th. The dress code for students is their Sunday best that follows CPSB Policy. Jeans and shorts are not allowed. If you have to ask or don't know about the clothing, it is probably not appropriate.

Kindergarten Commencement and 8th Grade Commencement, and the activities following the commencement ceremonies, are for Herndon kindergarteners and Herndon 8th graders. Students from other Caddo Parish schools are not allowed to attend either event. Also, Herndon siblings are not allowed to attend either event. They will be asked to leave, and the school they attend may be notified.
