Also, please make sure you are familiar with the Caddo Parish School Board policy on tardiness to school, which can be found in the student handbook at www.caddoschools.org. All middle school students must wear their school IDs every day. Replacement badges are \$5.00. If a student forgets his/her badge, a temporary ID must be purchased in the office for \$1.00. Temporary badges are good for one day only. After two days with a temporary badge, a new school ID badge must be purchased. Temporary badges not paid for in a timely manner could result in your student missing extracurricular activities. Three or more temporary badges in a semester will result in some type of detention. Failure to wear the ID may result in school detention.
